



Nipper Themed Lunchbox



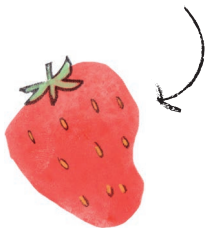
To make Nipper's face, score the top of a bread roll with a sharp knife, then peel away the areas that should be white. Try to keep the removed crust intact so that you can cut it into triangles for Nipper's ears

Use halved olives for Nipper's eyes and nose

You can use any filling for the bread roll, but if you use ham, you can make it into a tongue

You could include a sealed dressing pot of dip, such as hummus

Tip: Instead of cherry tomatoes and a savoury dip, you could use strawberries and a sweet dip

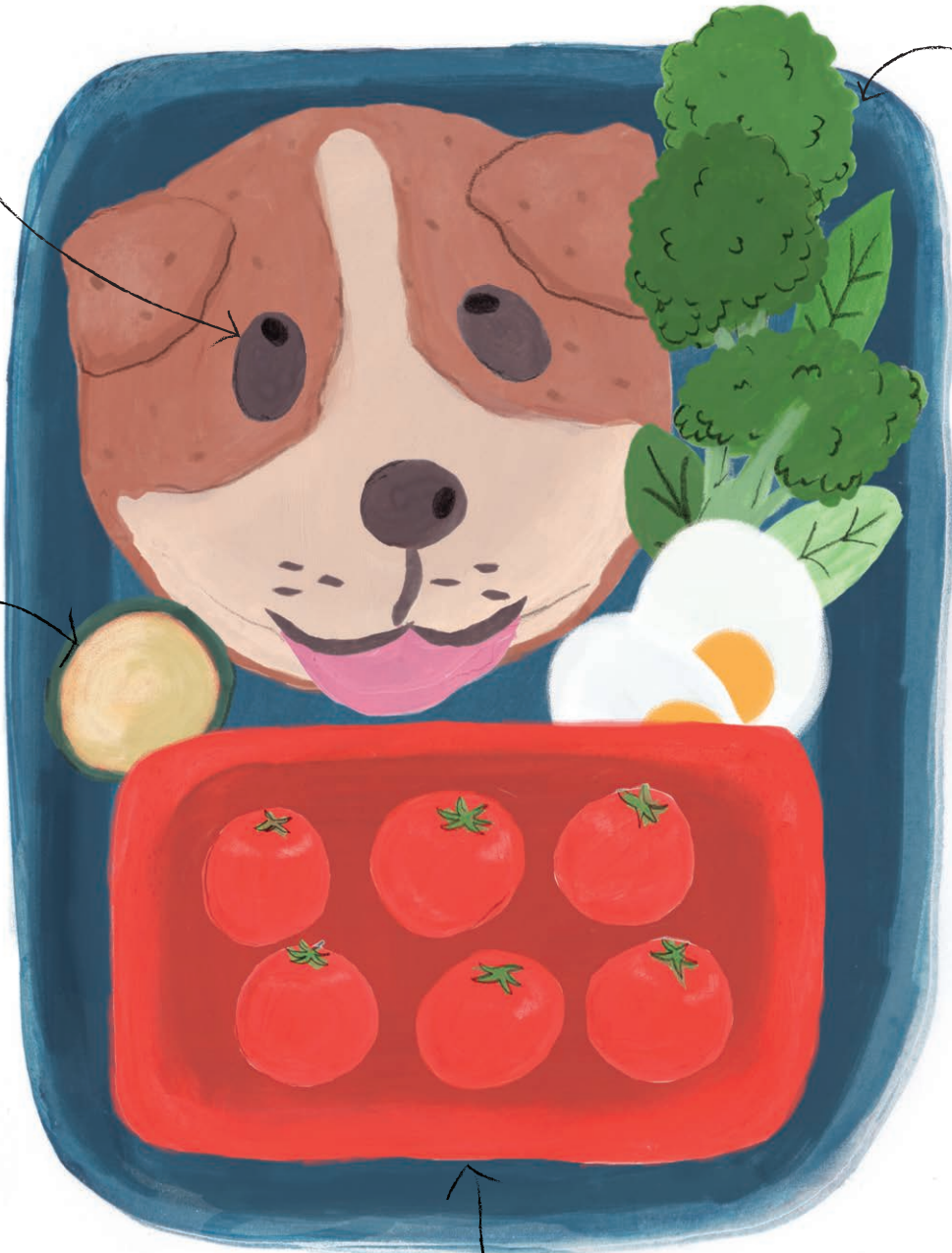


A red, rectangular silicon cake mould would hold a portion of cherry tomatoes or red bell pepper slices. It looks like Richard's lunchbox!

Use broccoli or salad leaves to fill in the gaps



Tip: Buy a small, bone shaped cookie-cutter and use it to cut sandwiches or cheese
