- Make a picnic lunch and eat it in the park.

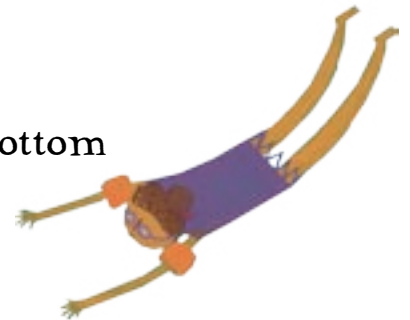
